


There were lots of behind the scene incidents as well, but you will have to ask a member who attended to find out more details here!!



### Snippets of information from our VAPS Historian, Alan Wilson ssvaps

- According to VAPS committee meeting minutes :
- Badges to clubs cost 6/- (60 cents), in 1953.
- A credit balance of 3/5 (33 cents) in one treasurer's report (3 March 1956).
- Insurance fees were listed as 3 pounds, 4 shillings and three pence (\$6.42) on 11 November 1961.
- In October 1966, a book on judging was released, a perennial theme.
- In 1953, Southern Suburbs was in a joint venture with the Cardiff Camera Club (an exchange of slide collections)
- Harry Potter was once secretary of the Geelong Camera Club
- The freight on an Interstate delivery by IPEC was 1/3 (12 cents)
- A treasurer's balance of 3/5 (34 cents) was recorded
- Shakespeare was a member of a camera club ... Bruce Shakespeare, that is
- One judge played the piano and did card tricks with his judging
- A petty cash entry of 2/- (20 cents) was recorded

### **Community Involvement**

The Club was approached in early February to see if it could help Alf Sutherland, a 95 year old ex POW, in restoring some old photos for a WW1 Honour Board [Staghorn Flat] of the district veterans. Alf was trying to recreate the board that was destroyed some years ago. *[Unfortunately Alf had no finance for the project, so the assistance was a good Samaritan request which they thought was worth asking for.]*

The Club was asked if it could help restore some photos that were small and poor in quality to a suitable size to go onto a board. *[Even if they were restored and improved just slightly so they could be used.]*

Club secretary, David Woolcock, volunteered WACC services as it was a good community project to be involved in as part of our Club's Diamond Jubilee Celebration year. The Club felt that Alf had already paid enough in serving our nation so this exercise was definitely pro bono.

Whilst the first batch of photos presented had been scanned, due to them being too small and of low resolution , the originals had to be sought to start from scratch.

Club President, David Willis, then took over the allocation of the tasks to various Club members who all did a surprisingly good job given the condition of the original images. In addition to the restored original images, President David organised, as an extra gift, a set of B&W images plus two DVD copies of the finished images showing the before and after results.

In all 30 images were restored by Club members who gave their time and expertise in taking part in this very worthwhile community project.


